Join a local British school as a Guest Exchange student, academic in-fill, join classes and learn about British school life

Full board accommodation in a Host Family - placements can be either single or double (with a student from a different nationality) depending on the size of the house
Welfare and support package provided by our local Student Liaison Officers to include an arrival orientation meeting, monthly contact and monthly reports submitted to the home agency

Once-per-term activity or social gathering for all students in the placement area, which is paid for by Educatius UK

Online access to handbook and contact telephone numbers

Return airport pick-up and drop-off by the Host Family or Educatius representatives from nearest designated airport within specified arrival window
